

Important Updates: MRH Transportation for 2025–2026

Dear MRH Families,

To improve safety and efficiency for our students and families, we are making some changes to how we manage school transportation.



Starting in the 2025-2026 school year, students who live one mile or more from their school, and are eligible for bus service, will receive a new bus card with built-in tracking called RFID. This pass will be used to scan when entering and exiting the bus, and families will be able to track their child's bus activity in real time using an app (more information below).

We are also using new routing software this year. It helps us better assign students to the correct bus routes and make those routes more efficient. All students will receive their new bus cards during their respective Back to School Nights.

We understand that in the past, some students who lived less than a mile from school may have been assigned to a bus due to older routing systems. With the new software, those routes are being updated, and that may mean some changes for families whose children have ridden the bus in previous years. We know this may raise questions and concerns, and we truly appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to improve our transportation services. If you are a family with students who previously rode the bus and do not receive a bus card, we ask that you use the transportation email below to inquire if your stop qualifies as a safety stop.
